## **Bangles of Boshiyamba**

Rumoured to have belonged to the witch dancer Boshiyamba, the bangles before you seem to shift slightly when you're not looking directly at them. Regardless of whether it's the original set Boshiyamba used to wear, or a crafty replica, their power is evident.

The bangles are made of gold, with geometric patterns as decorations. Worn together on the wrist they provide advantage to Performance (Dance) checks, and enable the Hypnotic Pattern spell to be cast once per day.

### **Bangles of Boshiyamba**

Wondrous item, rare (requires attunement)

Five golden bangles, loosely fitting on a slender humanoid wrist. You gain advantage to Performance (Dance) when you wear all five on one wrist.

Additionally you can cast Hypnotic Pattern once per day. The item recharges at midnight.

When separated, the bangles come magically together at midnight as well, converging on the spot where either most of them are, or on a wrist if at least one is worn.
