Harness of Gooseflight

Among the peoples settled around Pebble Lake in western Cardan the arrival of geese in early spring is an event celebrated since times immemorial. Even at the height of the Cardan empire the Goose dance and related festivities flourished.

One of the most peculiar costumes donned by the celebrants is the Harness of Gooseflight. The leather strips of the harness hold six goose wings on the back of the wearer. It is said that the best dancers are able to channel the powers of a goose spirit and take to the skies. The festive drinks made by the locals might be responsible for this rumour.

Harness of Gooseflight

Wondrous item, rare (requires attunement)

A simple leather harness with six goose wings on the back side. After a successful Performance (Dance) check the power of the harness is activated. You gain a flying speed of 60 feet for 1 hour, after which you slowly glide to the ground, if flying.

The dance can't be repeated and the wings activated until next dawn, and at least 12 hours must have passed since last flight.
