## Grasshopper Regalia

According to the catalogue, these strange accessories were given to the University by a wizard in exchange for access to some restricted tomes. Called the “Grasshopper Regalia” in the book, the set consists of a pair of knee-high boots, a strange rigid mantle, and a coronet with a pair of processes or antennae.

The boots and mantle are of similar leathery material, a bit like dry crumpled parchment, though the boots are thicker, with seven spines on the calves. The coronet feels wooden, and it has a certain spring to it, as do the protruding rods. The purpose of this regalia, seemingly imitating a grasshopper, is yet to be known.

### Grasshopper Regalia

Wondrous item, rare (requires attunement)

When you wear all three items, you can use the following features:

- As a bonus action you can jump six times your normal jump distance
- When you end your jump midair, you continue your movement in the same direction with a speed of 20 feet while losing 10 feet of altitude per turn until you land
- You take no falling damage and fall safely 60 feet per round while you are conscious and not restrained in any way
